Monday 25 July - Scrapstore craft session

Travel by minibus, leaving school at 10.00 and returning at 1.00. Tour of Scrapstore and free craft activity. Suitable for 5-10 year olds, no pre-school children please. Snack provided. £1.50 each. 1 adult may bring 2 children.

Wednesday 3 August - Blaise Castle playground and museum

Travel by coach, leaving school at 10.30 and returning at 3.00. Big adventure playground and country park with small museum. There are family activities at the museum. Bring a ball - and a bucket and spade if you have one! Bring a picnic or use the café at Blaise. £1 each. 1 adult may bring up to 4 children.

Thursday 4 August - Bike ride to At-Bristol

Fun and easy bike ride led by school staff, with free entry to At-Bristol Leave school at 10.00am, stay as long as you wish. Bring a picnic or use the café. £1.50 per person.

Wednesday 10 August - Windmill Hill City Farm

Travel by minibus, leaving school at 1.00 and returning at 4.00. Priority to children who have been to 'Farm Hands' group this year. Children will make a pizza, but bring extra snacks or use the farm café. £2 per person

Tuesday 30 August - Ferry trip and visit to M-shed museum

Everyone welcome. Leave school at 9.45 and walk to ferry stop at Temple Meads. There are family activities at M-shed and free entry to the exhibition. Stay as long as you like at M-shed and make your own way back. There is a café or you can bring your own snacks. £1 each. 1 adult may bring up to 3 children.

Friday 2 September - Open top bus trip

Leaving school at 12.30 for a 3-hour trip around the city. This trip is for families with a child coming into Reception in September. Bring a picnic to have on the Downs. $\pounds 1$ each person, maximum 4 tickets per family.
