What have we been learning?

Reception....This week reception completed their first piece of writing. Children recorded what they did during the winter holidays in their 'Busy Books' using pictures, words and even sentences!! We're glad to hear that the children had a good rest during the holidays.

Year 1... In Literacy this week we wrote our own adventure stories and enjoyed listening to a range of poems. In maths we focused on learning our number bonds to 10. Our new topic is learning about 'Animals including Humans'. At home, please ask your child to tell you the story of Handa's Surprise using actions.

Year 4... This week year 4 learned all about the human digestive system! They labelled the important organs in the digestive system, learned about what each organ does and how food is digested in our bodies. Year 4 have written poems about digestion and also written an explanation to explain the digestion process. At home, please support your child to practise the 11 and 12 times table at home.

Year 2... This week we wrote poems. We also learned how to use commands and questions in our writing. In topic we learned about Judaism and in maths we learned about graphs and how to answer questions. At home, please help your child to learn their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Year 3... This week we learned about keeping our bodies healthy. In English we looked at the poem 'The Dragon who ate our School' and wrote our own poems about a crazy day at school! In maths we revised column addition and subtraction. At home, please ensure your children read every day for 10 minutes.

Year 5... This week in English we have wrote guidance on how to write a kennings poem and then wrote and performed our own. In Maths we started to multiply four digit numbers by a one digit number using the column method. At home, please support your child with reading every day.

Year 6

This week we used fractions in lots of different ways and lots of different calculations. We have been letter writing in English and using our best persuasive language. In topic this week, we learnt about the process of how chocolate is made. We've been getting cravings! At home, please read our class blog and make a comment together!
