Year 2

Year 2 learnt about non-chronological reports this week as authors. In maths we made a fantastic start to our new topic shape and explored Concordes as historians. **Please read with your child five times a week and use Bug Club - ask your teacher if you have forgotten your login. Practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables including doing them out of order.**

Year 3

This week we continued to look at fractions as mathematicians and found out about what a child would do each day during Roman times. **Please help your child learn the 4 and 8 times tables. Please continue to encourage your child to read every day in a fluent voice.**

Year 4

As mathematicians we learnt to use hundredths as decimal numbers. As authors we explored explanation texts. As engineers we looked at how stringed instruments are made, and then designed and created our own! **At home make sure to keep learning spellings from your homework as well as the 9 times table! Read every night for 15 minutes.**

Year 5

Year 5 returned from camp and settled very nicely back into the swing of school life. We worked as scientists investigating mixtures. We also prepared to write to the president of Brazil to convince him to make deforestation of the Amazon illegal! **At home please make sure to keep learning those spellings from your homework! Read every night for 15 minutes.**




